WINEMAKING

COLLAGE

The pursuit of perfection is driven by a blend of cutting-edge winemaking technology and an unwavering commitment to showcasing the finest expression of the vintage. Each bottle is a testament to meticulous craftsmanship, blending the best of the best vineyard lots with access to five distinguished AVAs from the Aperture portfolio into a singular, breathtaking wine.

The result is a wine that captures the spirit of collaboration and creativity—an undeniable celebration of diversity, where every hand-selected lot contributes to a masterpiece that is greater than the sum of its parts.

The wine presents an intense yet nuanced fruit character, showcasing a range of textures and flavor profiles. Notes of green papaya and tropical fruits are complemented by a distinctive lemon meringue element that lifts and carries the citrus components.

"The inaugural release of the 2022 Collage Proprietary White is composed entirely of Sauvignon Blanc, sourced from across five American Viticultural Areas (AVAs) within Sonoma County, with the goal of crafting the finest Sauvignon Blanc the region has to offer in a given vintage. In the cellar, it was aged for 16 months in 60% new French oak puncheons and 40% neutral French oak, followed by six months in concrete. It takes a bright yellow/golden hue in the glass and offers a fantastic nose with detailed notes of nectarine, fresh flowers, honeyed citrus, vanilla, and lemon curd. The palate is full, silky, and pure, with a long finish. It takes on Bordeaux Blanc-like density and power, although it's expressive of its sense of place in Sonoma. It offers a ton of immediate pleasure and decadence, though it has the bones to improve over the next several years and drink its best over the coming 10-12 years.170 cases were produced."

WINEMAKING

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All blocks are located on higher elevation hillsides—none from the valley floor. Elevation is 900 feet or above. These wines feature a more robust tannin structure and greater potential for extended aging.

BLEND

Cabernet Sauvignon dominant but contains a small expression of all Bordeaux varietals: Malbec, Merlot, Petit Verdot, and Cabernet Franc.

SOIL TYPE | A complex interplay of soils—melding iron-rich and limestone-rich compositions—lends a Bordeaux-style expression to the wine. This fusion of mineral-rich terroirs enhances both freshness and minerality, supporting an elegant fruit profile and shaping the wine into a focused, layered symphony.

"A saturated red color, the 2021 Collage Proprietary Red is primarily Cabernet Sauvignon, blended with smaller amounts of Merlot and Malbec. It has a fantastic nose, with notes of crème de cassis, graphite, pristine floral perfume, and polished leather. The palate is full and weightless, with a completely seamless feel and a velvety texture, although its tannins have a more focused and detailed character. This team knows how to knock this type of wine out of the park and captures a level of refinement that is just stunning. Drink: 2026-2056."


COLLECTION

DESIGN FOCUS

A **design** approach inspired by the art of winemaking and photography can skillfully weave precision and spontaneity into a cohesive narrative. This concept, crafted by internationally renown Wine Label Designer, Chuck House, juxtaposes the fluid, organic nature of winemaking—captured in elements like a hand- drawn wax drip—with the exacting geometry of camera blades, their angular shapes pulled directly from images taken by legendary photographer Andy Katz, father to Winemaker Jesse Katz.

The design centered around the shapes of the camera blades, meticulously chosen to mirror the precision required to frame a photograph and to craft a wine. Their metered angles and layered arrangement evoke the discipline and artistry of both crafts. The color palettes within the design are uniquely created from cutouts of Andy Katz's original photographs, carefully selected from a lifetime of work captured across the globe. These fragments—sourced from vineyards, cityscapes, nature, and cultural moments—infuse the blades with rich textures and authentic hues that span decades and continents. The result is a visual mosaic where each color is a direct imprint from Andy's artistic journey, layering in global perspective, memory, and personal history.


The contrast is striking: the wax drip, raw and free-flowing, represents the creative intuition of winemaking, while the exacting shapes of the camera blades ground the design in a visual language of precision. Together, they create a dynamic interplay, a harmonious tension that reflects the duality of both crafts. This design not only pays homage to the photographer's path but also elevates the wine as a snapshot of its own unique moment in time—capturing the essence of a vintage with the same deliberate artistry as framing a photograph.

ABOUT THE DESIGNER: Chuck House's influence in the wine industry is both profound and farreaching. Over his celebrated career, House has collaborated with some of the most iconic names in the world of wine, including Paul Hobbs, the Araujo family, Helen Turley, Randall Grahm, Maya Dalla Valle, Nicholas Catena, Francoise Peschon, Jesse Katz and Marchese Lodovico Antinori. His work has shaped the visual identity of wines that are now considered benchmarks, including the timeless designs of Frog's Leap, Masseto, among many others.









WINEMAKER Jesse Katz

Jesse's diverse experience spanning 25 harvests at wineries, along with his passion to travel, fueled his aspiration to learn from the best in the industry, including Pétrus in Bordeaux, as well as time on the winemaking teams at Screaming Eagle Winery and Robert Foley Winery in Napa Valley, and Viña Cobos and Bodega Noemia in Argentina.

In 2010, Jesse became the youngest head winemaker in the U.S. at Lancaster Estate. During his five-year tenure, he orchestrated the building of the new Roth winery, production facility, and tasting room, and received 90+ scores on every wine scored by the Wine Advocate, and garnered Lancaster Estate's inclusion on the list of Wine Spectator's Top 100 Wines. In 2013, Wine Enthusiast named Jesse one of its 40 Under 40 Tastemakers and he was also the fi st winemaker on the Forbes 30 Under 30 list in 2014.

As a consulting winemaker for some of the biggest names in entertainment, including Von Miller, Tony Hawk and Justin Timberlake, in 2017, Jesse's wine collaboration with Shep Gordon, earned acclaim as the most expensive wine in the world.

This immersive experience brought together sound and taste in a truly unique way—highlighting the art of blending in both music and wine.
