WINEMAKER NOTES

The Estate Sauvignon Blanc from the esteemed Farrow Ranch estate in Alexander Valley exemplifies the 2024 vintage's most intricate and distinguished characteristics. This year, this Sauvignon Blanc is completely from Block 16, planted in the late 1980s.

Block 16 is composed of red volcanic soil. This soil composition, combined with a precise aging process in French oak barrels, results in a white wine of exceptional quality. The Estate Sauvignon Blanc offers concentrated flavors, complex aromatics, vibrant acidity, and a finely tuned minerality, which reflects the unique terroir of this block.

This release embodies the depth and character of the Farrow Ranch estate, showcasing a refined expression of the vineyard's Sauvignon Blanc heritage.
